By signing up for or using JAS Entities Solutions' website (jasentiessolutions.com), content, apps, products, and services (the "Service") you consent to the collection and uses of your information as described in this Privacy Policy. The Service is owned and operated by JAS Entities Solutions, LLC. ("JAS Entities Solutions", "we" or "us"). Information We Collect and How We Use It

Your JAS Entities Solutions Account Information

To use most features of the Service, you must create an account with JAS Entities Solutions. When you create an account with JAS Entities Solutions, you must provide us your name and email address, and create a password. Your email address and password will be used together so you can securely access and maintain your JAS Entities Solutions account. We may also collect additional optional information from you such as location and demographic information.

Your Actions on JAS Entities Solutions

When you use the JAS Entities Solutions Services, we collect information about the actions you take, including, entering comments or annotations, and following topics or users.

Information We Collect Automatically

Like almost all web and mobile products, we automatically collect a variety of information when you use the JAS Entities Solutions Services:

- *Log Data.* Our servers automatically record information about your interaction with our products (log data), including information that your browser or your mobile app sends. This log data may include your Internet Protocol (IP) address, the address of the web page you were visiting before you came to JAS Entities Solutions, browser type and settings, the date and time of your request, and actions you take on JAS Entities Solutions.
- *Cookie Data.* Like many websites, we use "cookies" (a small text file sent to your browser and stored on your device), or similar technologies. We use cookies so that when you re-access JAS Entities Solutions we can automatically log you in or populate the log-in fields for you. You can disable cookies through your browser,

however, disabling cookies may limit your ability to use the JAS Entities Solutions Services.

- *Web Beacon.* A "web beacon," also known as an Internet tag, pixel tag or clear GIF, is used to transmit information back to a web server. We also use pixel tags in our emails to customers to track effectiveness, response rates, and similar information about when our emails are read or forwarded.
- *Device Information.* We may collect information about the device you're using JAS Entities Solutions on, including what type of device it is, what operating system you're using, device settings, unique device identifiers, and crash data.
- *Analytics.* We may also use third party applications and services, such as Google Analytics, to collect and analyze information about visitor traffic on our sites and mobile applications. We use this information to analyze and improve the JAS Entities Solutions Services. This information includes general usage information, and may include information such as the number and frequency of our visitors, which pages or features they have visited, which links on the JAS Entities Solutions Services they have clicked on, and the length of those visits.

Personally Identifiable Information

We collect Personally Identifiable Information or "PII" such as your email address when you register for a JAS Entities Solutions Membership. We may share Personally Identifiable Information and Non-PII with certain third parties selected by us to help support our operations.

Third Party Advertising

On our websites, we and other third parties, such as ad network and analytics providers, may collect information about your online activities to provide advertising about products and services tailored to your individual interests. These third parties also help us track the effectiveness of our marketing efforts. You may see certain ads on this and other sites because we participate in ad networks. Ad networks allow us and others to target advertising to users through demographic, behavioral and contextual means. These networks track your online activities over time across third-party websites or online services by collecting information through automated means, including through the use of cookies, web server logs, web beacons and other methods. The ad networks use this information to show you advertisements for JAS Entities Solutions and others that are tailored to your individual interests. The information our ad network vendors collect includes your IP address and information about your visits to websites that participate in the vendors advertising networks, such as the pages or advertisements you have viewed, and the actions you take on the sites. This data collection and ad targeting take place both on our websites and on third-party websites that participate in the ad networks.

How We Use Your Information

We use your information, including your personal information, for the following purposes:

- To tailor the content and information that we may send or display to you, to offer location customization, content suggestions, targeted advertising, and personalized help and instructions, and to otherwise personalize your experiences while using service.

For example, we may use your information, such as your email address, to send you news and newsletters, special offers, and promotions, or to otherwise contact you about products or information we think may interest you. We may share information if we believe that disclosure is reasonably necessary to comply with a law, regulation or legal request; to protect the safety, rights, or property of the public, any person, or JAS Entities Solutions; or to detect, prevent, defend against or otherwise address abuse, fraud, security or legal issues.
